We would like you to be aware of the new voting options for seniors (65 and over), travellers and incapacitated voters for the current general election.

The advanced polls for **September 17th and 18th** will be located as follows:

- **Constituencies 1 – 9:** Midlands Heights Seventh Day Adventist Church Hall
- **Constituencies 10-18:** National Sports Centre, Sports Pavillion
- **Constituencies 19-27:** St. Paul AME Church Hall, City of Hamilton ✓ *Updated*
- **Constituencies 28-36:** St. Mary's Church Hall

The advanced Polls for Saturday, September 19th will be located as follow:

- **Constituencies 1 – 18:** Bermuda College, Cafeteria, Paget
- **Constituencies 19-36:** St. Mary's Church Hall, Warwick



CURRENTLY ALL POLLS WILL BE OPEN DAILY FROM 8AM TO 8PM.

Please ensure that you bring your government photo ID. Government ID includes:

- Valid driver's license, or
- Voter Identification card, or
- Valid Passport, or
- Special Person's Card issued by Transport Control Department

All voters must wear a facemask and will have their temperature taken and hands sanitized prior to entering the polling stations.

If you are unable to attend the polls due to a medical condition, your doctor can submit a medical certificate for you to vote from home. **This information must be submitted to the parliamentary registry TODAY (September 17th) at 5pm** and can be done online at www.elections.gov.bm. Polling at home for sick and shut in voters will take place between September 21-25, 2020.

If you are under isolation due to COVID-19 please have your physician submit a medical certificate for voting from home. **This information must be submitted to the parliamentary registry TODAY (September 17th) at 5pm** and can be done online at www.elections.gov.bm. Polling at home for sick and shut in voters will take place between September 21-25, 2020

The parliamentary registry will contact those that are approved for voting from home once their application has been accepted.

Every effort is being made to ensure that Bermudians have a safe voting experience.
